Structural racism and implicit biases have created widespread inequities in the youth legal system. Across the country, youth of color are overrepresented at nearly every point of contact with the youth legal system as compared to their white peers who have engaged in similar behaviors. The Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Act (JJDPA), requires states to address racial and ethnic disparities in the youth legal system. This conversation will focus on gaining a better understanding of the problems that exist, and ways we can work together to correct them.
